

“My heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.” Romans 10:1

When the First Sunday of Advent arrives on November 27, 2011, all English-speaking Catholics will use a new, corrected translation of the Holy Mass. These columns until then are given so that we can all be fully prepared to embrace the adjustments next Advent.

This week, we look at the second part in our catechesis on the *Gloria*. The first part of this ancient hymn that we looked at last week is addressed to God the Father. The second part is addressed to God the Son.

The current translation reads:

Lord Jesus Christ, **only Son of the Father**,  
 Lord God, Lamb of God,  
 you take away the **sin** of the world: have mercy on us;  
 you are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer.  
 For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord,  
 you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ,  
 with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father.  
 Amen.

In Advent 2011 the faithful will sing instead:

Lord Jesus Christ, **Only Begotten Son**,  
 Lord God, Lamb of God, **Son of the Father**,  
 you take away the **sins** of the world, have mercy on us;  
**you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer;**  
**you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.**  
 For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord,  
 you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ,  
 with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father.  
 Amen.

A line-by-line comparison it a bit difficult because some of the changes involve moving the text around.

For instance, the pair of phrases in the first part:

will be replaced with three lines:

you take away the **sin** of the world: have mercy on us;  
 you are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer

you take away the **sins** of the world, have mercy on us;  
**you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer;**  
**you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.**

Having the triple invocation (“have mercy on us ... receive our prayer ... have mercy on us”) is reminiscent of similar structures found in the *Agnus Dei* and *Kyrie*. It is also more faithful to the Latin structure of the hymn.

There is one other minor change in these lines that is worth mentioning. The new translation now reads “you take away the **sins** of the world. While a minor change in comparison to the rest of the *Gloria*, there is an important theological point to be made here. When we say that Christ came to take away the *sin* (singular) of the world, we speak rightly, but we are emphasizing that he combats sin in general, perhaps even referring to original sin. This is certainly true, but Christ also came to take away personal sins, and it is this reality that is seemingly emphasized in the Latin text of the *Gloria* (as well as the *Agnus Dei*). Again, this takes nothing away from the reality that Christ destroys evil in general and that Baptism washes away the stain of original sin, but the word in the *Gloria* is specifically plural, and hence recognizes our own personal sins and the saving reality of Christ’s grace.
