

For the Love of St. Peter School!

In the Gospel today, we hear the parable Jesus told about the "Good Samaritan"...an outsider who was moved with compassion to help his brother in need. This parable has been a remarkable way of remembering the second of the two-fold command Jesus gave to all of His disciples: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Looked at from the perspective of St. Peter School, I think this parable speaks to our current situation. The last few years brought many difficulties to our school. While many of our parishioners were unaware of these problems, the parents patiently endured them for the sake of their children. In some ways, we can say that it fell victim to the robbers. Like the priest and the Levite in the parable, there are some who have shown that they are willing to "cross the road to the other side" and leave our school to fester in its problems. However, that will not happen. I have stepped up and many have joined me to renew our school and its mission of Catholic education in our community of Gueydan. The question is: will parents turn with a helping hand like the Good Samaritan and help to take care of the school's needs (like seeing our need for an increased enrollment and choosing to send their children to our school)? I realize that some have experienced hurt through the years, some remain angry, and some have made rash or imprudent choices because of emotion. What is needed is mercy...the Lord's grace, which reconciles and forgives. And His words in the Gospel today are: "Go and do likewise" [treat the victim with compassion.] Can we see our school needed that mercy and respond according to the Lord's command?

Of course, there are so many people in our community of Gueydan with good will toward our school. Our many benefactors have been and continue to be so generous to St. Peter School. Recently, a couple who are parishioners donated a new sign for the front of St. Peter School. They did so, wishing to remain anonymous. This and the many other random acts of kindness clearly show that not everyone will keep walking across the road with their heads turned away from our school's needs.

I challenge our Catholic parents in particular to sincerely ask if you are the Good Samaritan in regard to St. Peter School.
