

“My heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.” Romans 10:1

Dear Friends,

During this month of the Holy Rosary, we are given the opportunity to deepen our understanding of this ancient prayer and renew our devotion to our Mother Mary through the recitation of it. Our Holy Father, Pope John Paul II, loved the Rosary and often spoke about it. His most moving words about the Holy Rosary were expressed in his Apostolic Letter, *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*, written a few years before his death.

In his Apostolic Letter, Pope John Paul II pointed out two important things about the Holy Rosary:

1- The Rosary is a thoroughly Biblical prayer. It includes the meditation on the mysteries of Christ's life that the Holy Scriptures tell us about. Because of this, the praying of the Rosary is one form of praying with the Word of God.

2- The Rosary is a powerful prayer because it brings us into contact with the mysteries of Christ's life, most especially through the memories of Mary. Only she witnessed the events of Christ's life from the very beginning...so only she can help us understand them. St. Luke tells us a few times that Our Lady lived with her eyes fixed on Christ, treasuring His every word: “*She kept all these things, pondering them in her heart*” (Lk 2:19; cf. 2:51). Pope John Paul II says, “The memories of Jesus, impressed upon her heart, were always with her, leading her to reflect on the various moments of her life at her Son's side. In a way those memories were to be the “rosary” which she recited uninterruptedly throughout her earthly life. Even now, amid the joyful songs of the heavenly Jerusalem, the reasons for her thanksgiving and praise remain unchanged. They inspire her maternal concern for the pilgrim Church, in which she continues to relate her personal account of the Gospel. *Mary constantly sets before the faithful the “mysteries” of her Son*, with the desire that the contemplation of those mysteries will release all their saving power. In the recitation of the Rosary, the Christian community enters into contact with the memories and the contemplative gaze of Mary.”

Let us approach Our Lady through the Holy Rosary and let her teach us about Christ and the mysteries of His life. The more we do, the more she will tell us as she did His disciples: “*Do whatever He tells you.*” (John 2:5) Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, pray for us!
