Dear Friends,

As we prepare for the time to change and the darkness to come a little earlier, the Church nears the end of her liturgical year. This week we observe the annual feasts of All Saints and All Souls. On Monday, we contemplate the Saints in glory who have achieved the victory of faith and now live forever with the Lord. They show that the noble calling Christ gives to all of us to be saints is possible to achieve! What St. Paul said while on earth (which we hear in today's second reading), is equally true for him and the other saints in Heaven: "We always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling and powerfully bring to fulfillment every good purpose and every effort of faith, that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in Him." May their prayers help us to be worthy of the calling we have received and, through God's grace, bring it to fulfillment in our lives!

On Tuesday, the Church ponders anew the mystery of death that every human person will one day share in. But we do so with the hope given by Christ Jesus who has conquered death and opened the way to Eternal Life. We remember our loved ones who have died in Christ and pray that they be brought to the fullness of His glory in Heaven if they are still experiencing His purifying mercy in Purgatory. The great Cajun tradition of cleaning, painting, and readying tombs for All Souls Day expresses our communion with the faithful departed. We hold their memory dear, and with our prayers, bring them to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

As we ponder the Church Triumphant on the feast of All Saints and the Church Suffering on the feast of All Souls, we are reminded that we belong to the Church Militant and must continue the battle against sin in our personal lives and in the world. It is a difficult battle. None of the Saints deny this. But what they show us is that Christ's grace is all-powerful, and if we are filled with His life, striving for holiness, the victory will be ours! For our departed brothers and sisters, we pray: Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them. *Amen.* To Our Lady and all the Saints, we pray: Pray for us, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. *Amen!*

ALL SOULS DAY...PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE DEPARTED VISITING A CEMETERY

A plenary indulgence is granted, applicable, in this case, only to the souls in Purgatory, to one who visits a cemetery and prays, even if only mentally, for the departed November 1 through November 8. A plenary indulgence is the remission of all temporal punishment due to sin. Even when sin is forgiven and eternal punishment is remitted there often remains temporal punishment. That temporal punishment is possibly described as attachments to creatures as obstacles to perfect union with God. Each year on November 2, ALL SOULS DAY, we are invited to gain PLENARY INDULGENCE for the faithful departed. Such an indulgence removes all temporal punishment. To gain the indulgence one must:

1. Visit a cemetery.
2. Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and Apostles' Creed).
3. Confess one's sins to a priest within the week before or the week after November 2.
4. Receive Holy Communion on November 2.
5. Be detached from all sin, mortal and venial.

Seek to gain this wonderful indulgence for all of the dearly departed... only one may be gained. "It is good and holy to pray for the dead..." 2 Maccabees 12:45
