

“My heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.” Romans 10:1

Dear friends,

On this solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we celebrate the feast of God as He has revealed Himself: one God who exists as a trinity of persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This is the central mystery of our faith, on which all the other truths of our faith rest. We will never understand this mystery fully in this life, but as the Lord Jesus tells us in the gospel, God freely shares His life and love with us, and for this great gift, we respond with gratitude: *Glory be to the Father, to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen!*

In anticipation of the Feast of the Lord's Body and Blood next weekend, I'd like to discuss with you the way we receive Holy Communion. At the present moment, there are two options when receiving Holy Communion in the United States: directly in the mouth, or in the hand. The normative manner of receiving Holy Communion for the whole Church throughout the world is in the mouth (on the tongue). In some countries, like America, there is a special permission given to receive the Sacred Host in the hand. However, when this is done, extreme care must be taken. When Holy Communion is received in the hand, there always remains the possibility of the Sacred Host being dropped. This has happened a few times recently. This is the reason we use the Communion Patens. We must also constantly re-examine the way we receive Holy Communion.

If you choose to receive Holy Communion in your hand, the way in which your hand is presented is very important. Writing in the 4th century, St. Cyril of Jerusalem said this: “In approaching therefore, come not with your wrists extended, or your fingers spread; but make your left hand a throne for the right, as for that which is to receive a King.” Your hand should never be closed or half-way closed; neither should your hands be joined together; neither should a person reach out to grab the Sacred Host. Rather, the proper way to receive in the hand is to place your left hand flat over your right hand. Then, you carefully pick up the Sacred Host with your right hand and place it in your mouth.

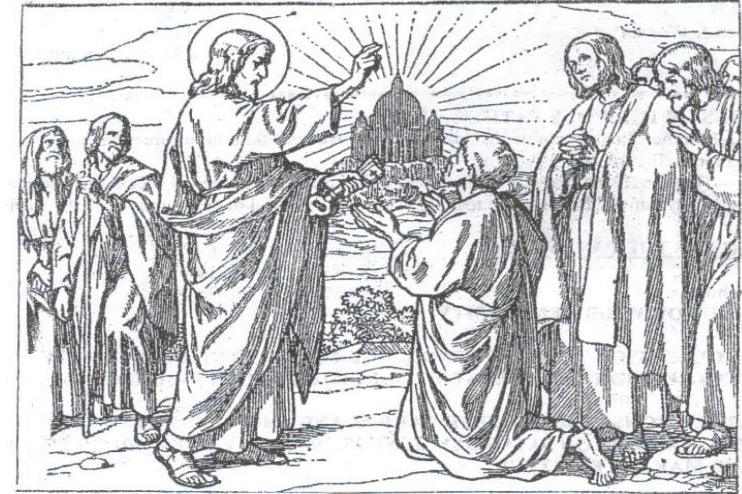
Let us redouble our efforts to receive the Holy Eucharist worthily and reverently.
