At the current time, the school is receiving some necessary facility updates, the curriculum is being reviewed, teachers are being hired, and many other preparations are underway for a great new school year. 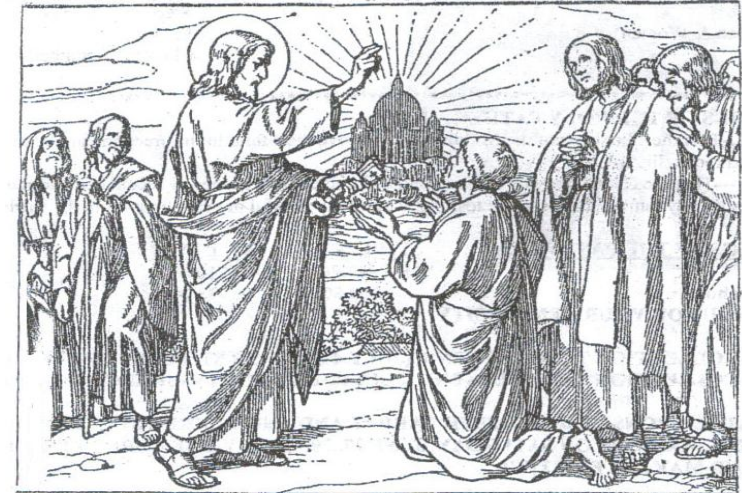
