I would like to address in particular the negativity that has surrounded St. Peter School for some time and that certain people continue to perpetuate. In recent weeks, there was a discussion in an online forum about whether or not half of St. Peter School would be transferring to Kaplan. Likewise, the naysayers continue to influence other people with their negative ideas- many of them not true. Let me make it clear: **a new day has arrived!!** As I clearly expressed at the town hall meeting held in May, we have faced many challenges in recent years that many people witnessed get worse as time went on. I am aware of those issues and have put forward plans for positive change. It has been asked if I will do all that I have said? One word: yes! If you refuse to believe, just you wait and see! At this time, the entire curriculum is under review, teachers are being hired, and plans are being made for a successful 2010-2011 school year.

However, at the present time, the enrollment remains fairly low. Some parents intend to send their children to St. Peter School for only the elementary grades. Let me remind you that our school is Pre-K through 8th grade. We likewise need students to teach in the upper grades. Our students did very well this past year as shown by the increase in their test scores across the board, and of course, all of our 8th grade students passed the Leap test. I am confident that with the addition of new teachers and with all we're doing to strengthen the curriculum, our students will do even better during the coming year in achieving academic excellence. In a similar manner, we are placing a renewed emphasis on our Catholic Faith in the coming year, and it will bear great fruit. Simply stated, we need more students enrolled.
