Dear Friends,

The Precepts of the Catholic Church are a description of the absolute minimum actions required of Catholics regarding the Church. Yet, it seems so many people have forgotten them. The Church uses these precepts to remind us that the Christian life requires a commitment to prayer and active participation in the liturgy and the sacraments. If we fall below this bare-minimum level, we can't rightly consider ourselves to be in full communion with the Lord or His Church. This examination of Conscience should help you reflect on how you are responding to the demands made by the love of God.

First Precept of the Church

YOU SHALL ATTEND HOLY MASS ON SUNDAYS AND HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION.

Second Precept of the Church

YOU SHALL CONFESS YOUR SINS AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR. Have I...

- made a good confession of my mortal sins at least once a year?
- Purposely omitted telling my mortal sins in my last confession?
- performed the penance I was given?
- made reparation for any harm I have done to others?

Third Precept of the Church

YOU SHALL HUMBLY RECEIVE YOUR CREATOR IN HOLY COMMUNION AT LEAST DURING THE EASTER SEASON Have I...

- fulfilled my Easter duty to receive Holy Communion at least once during the Lenten and Easter Seasons?
- received Holy Communion while in the state of mortal sin?
- fasted an hour before receiving Holy Communion?
- received Holy Communion more than twice in one day?

YOU SHALL KEEP HOLY THE HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION

Fifth Precept of the Church

YOU SHALL OBSERVE THE PRESCRIBED DAYS OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE. Have I...

- done penance every Friday, if not abstaining from meat, then some other form of penance?
- fasted on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday?
- spent time in prayer, doing spiritual and corporal works of mercy, and practicing self-denial?

YOU SHALL CONTRIBUTE TO THE SUPPORT OF THE CHURCH Have I...

- contributed a just amount of my time/talents/money to support my parish and work of the Church?

Seventh Precept of the Church

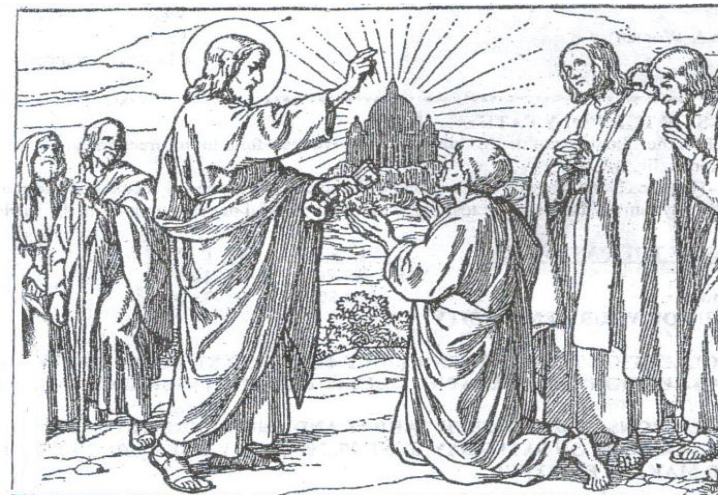
YOU SHALL OBSERVE THE LAWS OF THE CHURCH CONCERNING MARRIAGE. Have I...

- been living in a valid and licit marriage according to the laws of the Catholic Church?
