Dear Friends,

In today's Second Reading, St. Paul tells us who we gather before every time we celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. It's no mere human gathering...and it's ultimately not about us. St. Paul says, "you have approached Mount Zion and the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and countless angels in festal gathering, and the assembly of the firstborn enrolled in heaven, and God the judge of all, and the spirits of the just made perfect, and Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and the sprinkled blood that speaks more eloquently than that of Abel."

With these words, St. Paul challenges us to see with the eyes of faith that when we celebrate the Holy Eucharist, we approach God and His holy place of Heaven. We join the angels and the saints in worship of Him, whose body and blood saves us from our sins. This is a sacred gathering...and it must be approached faithfully and worthily.

At the end of last week, Francis Cardinal George, the President of the USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) announced that the Holy Father Pope Benedict has approved the new English translation of the *Roman Missal*. This means that as of the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011, our celebration of Holy Mass will be with a new English translation...the same Mass, but with different, more beautiful words. This new translation will help our celebration of the Holy Mass to be more sacred...and will help us to better lift our minds and hearts to God. November 2011 may seem like a long time from now, but it will come quickly. We are being given this time to prepare ourselves for the new translation as well as to allow publishers time to prepare texts.

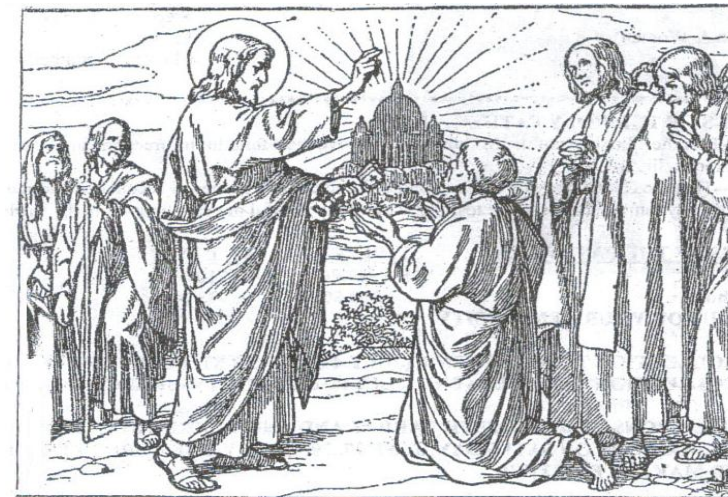
We will have many opportunities here in our parish to be prepared to receive the new English translation of the Mass with understanding and gratitude. In the meantime, great information about the new translation along with many other resources can be found at the USCCB's website: www.usccb.org/romanmissal

Bishop Arthur Serratelli of Paterson, New Jersey, Chair of the Bishops' Committee on Divine Worship, voiced gratitude for the approval, "I am happy that after years of preparation, we now have a text that, when introduced late next year, will enable the ongoing renewal of the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy in our parishes."

Msgr. Anthony Sherman, Director of the Secretariat for Divine Worship of the USCCB noted, "A great effort to produce the new *Roman Missal* for the United States, along with the other necessary resources, has begun. Even as that work is underway a full-scale catechesis about the Liturgy and the new *Roman Missal* should be taking place in parishes, so that when the time comes, everyone will be ready."

Let us strive to worship our Lord Jesus Christ as He said His Father wants: in Spirit and in truth (John 2:21,23)
