Dear Friends,

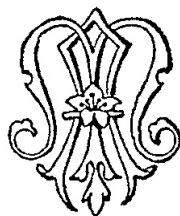
This month of October is traditionally observed by faithful Catholics as the Month of the Holy Rosary, with the liturgical memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7. This month is meant to inspire us to rediscover this traditional prayer, so simple yet so profound.

As Pope John Paul often reminded us, the Holy Rosary is a powerful way of contemplating the face of Christ...of seeing Him with the eyes of Mary. At its core, the Rosary is based on the Gospel scenes of the life of Christ. Throughout the Church's history, it has been a fundamental way of getting to know Jesus and a great source of personal conversion. The Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary has been a source of comfort for those in sorrow or fear as well as a powerful weapon in the face of dangers and evil threats. The Second Vatican Council fully endorsed it for our times, and both Pope John Paul II and Pope Benedict have enthusiastically recommended it.

The importance of rediscovering the power of the Rosary is seen in regard to our great need for peace. The threat of terrorism continues to grow stronger and wars continue to be waged. In each of her apparitions (Rue de Bac [Paris], Lourdes, Fatima), Our Lady has called for the praying of the Rosary precisely for peace. How desperately we need her powerful intercession to convert the hearts of sinners and bring the peace of God's presence to our world! This is true for nations...but also for families. How much peace would flow into family relationships if the family would begin again to pray the Rosary together.

Let us strengthen our devotion to Holy Rosary by praying it daily and with great faith during this month of October. Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, pray for us!
