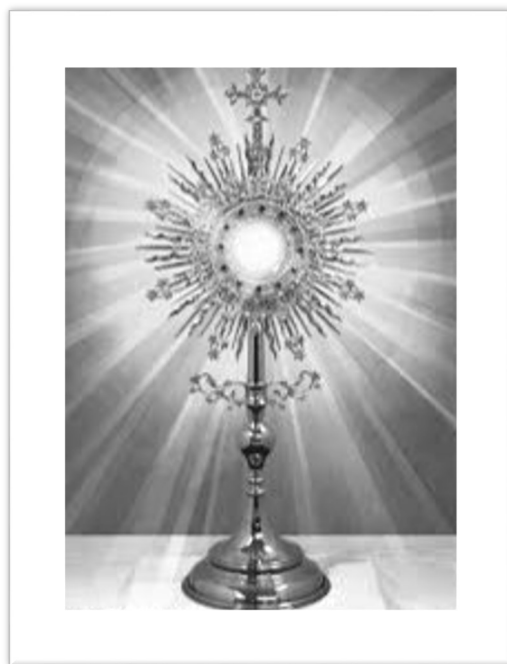
Perpetual Adoration
