

CCD School Year 2020-21

Father and I were discussing this coming year for the CCD classes and felt in light of the current situation, we would call on the parents to lead the teaching of the catechism to their children with guidance and direction from the volunteer Catechists.

The plan for 2nd through 9th grade is to have four (4) classes, one to start the year handing out textbooks and assigning the goals for the first period, the next two classes would review their progress and assign new goals, and the final class to review the entire years' goals to determine the student's ability to progress to the next level.

The scheduled dates are:

Sunday, Nov 15th

Sunday, Jan 24th

Sunday, Mar 14th

Sunday, May 16th

All classes would be from 08:30 - 10:10.

The last few years the 1st grade was not offered due to the lack of teachers. This year would include 1st Grade in preparation to enter the CCD program in 2nd grade with a base knowledge of prayers and general knowledge of the Mass, Confession and receiving Holy Communion. This will be done at home only (no formal classes), with some general guidance and program book, which will be available at the office.

In step with the Diocese current guidelines, all students above the 2nd grade are required to wear face masks, as well as the teachers, and all efforts will be made to keep 6 foot separation during the classes.

Our children's instruction and development in the faith is essential, especially in today's social climate, to provide a concrete base to assist in navigating life. So, as we work together, let us prepare our children for life surrounded by the light of Christ.
