## **“Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen.” Hebrews 11:1**

God is ever eager to help us. He does not put obstacles to our sanctification or salvation. However, we do put up obstacles. The consequences of sin come through our choices, not God’s will. Faith makes is evident unseen realities because it makes present in us the fulfillment of God’s promises. For example, we examine the lives of the saints and find their hope in God was not for naught. They hoped in God and God saved them. What will it take for us to believe that God wants to help us?

God is not out to get us, nor does he prowl about seeking to find fault in us. Sin has its own consequences baked into them. God does not need to prowl about in search of it. The devil does prowl about. He seeks to keep us in our sin and convince us that our sin either does not matter, or is so horrible God has no time for us. God wants to heal us of our sins and save us.

Faith needs to be put into practice. Perhaps we put our faith on the shelf expecting God to do something before we act. Faith helps us to recognize what God is doing. Through the activity of our faith we perceive what God is doing and the direction he wants us to go in. When we are unsure we should pray for enlightenment and wait. Many times God wants us to wait with him before revealing to us what we need. Other times we need to make a decision and have no time to wait. In these cases we should pray, even if briefly, and go with what our gut tells us. You may make a mistake, but even in this God will be with you. God proves his faithfulness through sticking with us in good times and in bad.

The eagerness of God for each of us is not to make us all millionaires. The eagerness of God is to see our potential fulfilled. We each reach our potential in different ways. What if one person reaches their potential through using their wealth and influence for good and another cured cancer? Can you really say one is fulfillment and the other is not? The trouble for us is that we do not have the perspective that God has. That is why we often go our own way believing that it is better, rather than trusting in the promises of God.

God’s patience is directed to our salvation. This means he puts up with much of our poor choices, but he does so for our salvation. In other words, God plays the long game. He endures the sins we commit with patience in order to bring about salvation. This is, for example, how you love children who have suffered previously. They struggle to be loved. They hoard food, believing it to be scarce. They reject love, believing it to be false. You demonstrate to them that your love is sincere through offering it consistently. This is what God does for us. Faith is the language which helps us to recognize this and to begin to live by the promises of God.

The only thing we need to do to grow in faith is to use our faith. It is like a muscle that needs exercise. If you don’t feel that you know how to do that, ask God. He is able to work with all of our unique situations better than we can ever imagine. The trouble is never if God can help me. The trouble is always whether we think God can help or want to accept the help he offers. if we spent just spent a little more time inviting God’s help in our lives we would be much better off.

Dear brothers and sisters. The help we have in heaven is immense. All we really have to do is ask. Our Lady once said to St. Catherine Laboure that there are many graces meant for soul, but were not received because they were not asked for. As the gospel says, “Ask and you will receive. Seek and you will find. Knock and the door will be opened to you.” Let us all resolve to use our faith and seek the Lord.
